

DEATH CLAIM SUBMISSION PROCEDURE

DOCUMENT REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Death Certificate Form (Pacific form). Filled in by the treating doctor who examined the cause of death of the body.
- 2. A written notification is filled in by the policy holder (HRD).
- 3. Death certificate from the ward.
- 4. Post Mortem examination statement from the hospital.
- 5. Medical Summary Report along with medical supporting data such as laboratory results, X-rays, ultrasound, etc.
- 6. Accident report from the police (if the death was caused by an accident).
- 7. A copy of the Insured's and heir's KTP. If the beneficiary is underage, a copy of birth certificate.
- 8. A copy of family identity card.
- 9. A copy of marriage certificate.
- 10. Legal heir certificate
- 11. Chronology of events / final moments before the Insured died. Handwritten and signed by the beneficiary.
- 12. Other required supporting documents.
- 13. All documents in form of copies must be authenticated by the agency that issued the document as intended.
- 14. If the heir is underage, a certificate from the religious district court/ a notarial certificate to appoint a guardian are required. At the time of payment, the guardian signs the certificate.
